As I am sure you are all aware from your own Southern Link representatives, the TAP fund remains available for all those looking into benefitting their communities by collaborating with neighbouring parishes.

Mary Tavy Parish Council have a number of ideas which it thinks could benefit the wider communities. I write to you today to ask that you raise this correspondence at your next Parish or Town Council meeting as we would like to ask if you would support a joint TAP funding venture in the future

Mary Tavy Parish Council frequently receive letters from concerned parents living outside our own village, but whose children attend the local primary school. It is not surprising that parents are willing to travel from surrounding Parishes in order for their children to attend our school. It offers excellent indoor and outdoor education.

Therein lies one of the issues which could so easily be solved with the support of a neighbour. The school playing field lies a quarter of a mile away from the school along a road without a pavement. Amongst other ideas the Parish Council of Mary Tavy have looked into extra signage to make motorists aware of the school field and the possibility of children walking, the concept has been agreed by the school and DCC Highways, however funding is always the issue.

If you would support this venture or any other into the future please contact our Clerk as soon as convenient. Perhaps we in turn could help you complete a project through a similar joint TAP funding venture.
