Dear Brentor Parish Council,

We are hoping to put on a community event in Tavistock in the spring and are looking to apply for a grant to assist with this. After enquiring about TAP funding, I have been advised by Tavistock Town Council to contact a Parish Council who can support our application in conjunction with them.

The idea behind the day would be to invite other charitable organisations, GPs, Police, Community workers etc. to share (in the morning) the work that they do within the community in order to better educate the organisations currently out there and build strong partnerships so we know what help is available and how to refer to one another. We would like to promote the website www.advicewestdevon.org.uk so organisations in the area can learn to work together to benefit the community who may need help. This site allows partners to refer clients to one another to ensure that they are helped by the most appropriate service.

This would be followed by an open afternoon for the public to come and speak to these organisations at a free 'information and advice afternoon'. We hope that this will also raise awareness of what assistance is out there.

We do not currently have the money to fund this within our Charity's budget here at Citizens Advice- but several organisations have approached us and believe it would be worth facilitating. We are hoping to apply for a grant to cover the cost of this community days which would include room hire, publicity and refreshments etc.

We would be incredibly grateful if you would be willing to support us with this venture and allow us to include your Council as a supporter on the WDBC application for TAP funding.

I would appreciate any information you are able to give me to help facilitate a community information day in Tavistock.
