There is a pdf version of the response form which can downloaded and printed and when filled in posted to one of the above addresses.

But if you care about our beautiful countryside here in Devon as much as we do, we hope that you will be as concerned as we are about this proposal and that you will submit your comments on this consultation document before the 24th March deadline.
